Aleatico is a Corsican black Muscat variety, once the favorite wine of Napoleon Bonaparte. We've put a new twist on it by making it a dry aromatic white wine. Honey in color with a full range of aromatics including nutmeg, crisp green apple and honeysuckle. Pleasantly dry and crisp, it is approachable and must be tasted to be believed.

Winemaking process

The Aleatico is whole cluster pressed. Fermentation is cool and slow to lift the aromatics, typical of Muscat varieties. The wine was aged in small stainless-steel barrels for 5 months and then bottled in late February 2020.
