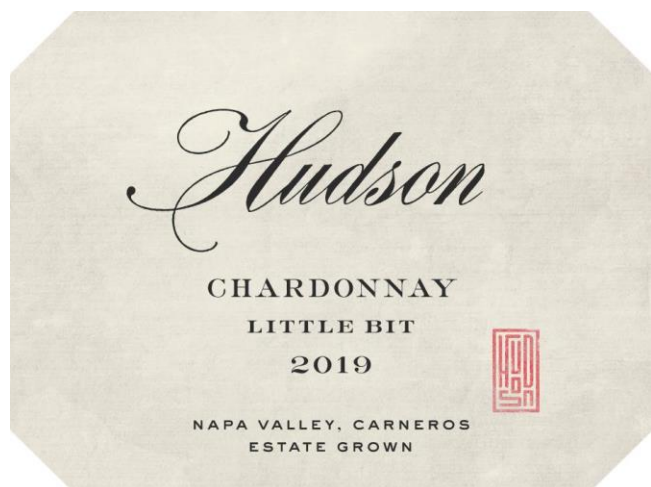


# 2019 LITTLE BIT CHARDONNAY

## VINEYARD

Named after Lee Hudson's granddaughter, Elizabeth Marley Hudson, affectionately known as "Little Bit". The Little Bit vineyard, planted in 2006, sits on the south end of the ranch in site of the San Pablo Bay. It's access to the cool bay breeze offers distinct characteristics to the grapes, which are known for producing wine with fresh acidity balancing out the richness of the fruit.

## WINEMAKING

The fruit was picked by hand at night, whole cluster pressed, and barrel fermented utilizing native yeast in 80% new French oak barrels. The wine is stirred regularly and aged sur lie, then settled and bottled unfiltered and unfinned after 23 months.

## TASTING NOTES

The 2019 Little Bit Chardonnay is extremely expressive with aromas of lemon tart, tangerine and clover honey exploding from the glass. The mouthfeel is full-bodied with a creamy texture, finishing with bright, well-balanced acidity.
